NEW LAW!!

Everyone must have at a minimum, a 10-Hour OSHA card by March 1st 2018!

March 1, 2018 – Every worker on a site requiring a Construction Superintendent, Site Safety Coordinator, or Site Safety Manager must have at least a 10-Hour OSHA Card.

December 1, 2018 – Every worker must have either a **"Site Safety Training" (SST) card**, a limited SST card, or a temporary SST card.

Every Construction Superintendent, Site Safety Coordinator, Site Safety Manager, Concrete Safety Manager or competent person must have a "Site Safety Training" Supervisor card (*see complete law below*).

May 1, 2019 – Every worker must have a SST card or temporary SST card.

***WHAT IS REQUIRED IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A SITE SAFETY TRAINING (SST) CARD?**

-10-Hour OSHA AND 30 -45 additional SST credits, including 8 in Fall Protection.

-30-Hour OSHA AND 10-23 additional SST credits, including 8 in Fall Protection.
